NGO World Christian Administration Business Promotion Plan

NGO World Christian Administration has 11 business departments with separate business promotion plans for each department as follows.



1. DEPARTMENT OF DIPLOMATIC REALTIONS

- (1) Establishment of a Ngo World Christian Administration embassy with an accredited ambassador to every country in the world.
- (2) Approval of establishment of branch NGO World Christian Administration from world countries and its department minister appointment there.
- (3) Establishment of International special ambassador system and the appointment of International special ambassadors.
- (4) Seek the diplomatic resolution of human rights issues related to Christians and Christian ministries persecution.
- (5) The goal of establishing freedom of religion for every country in the world.
- (6) On the spot Investigations and Analysis focused on identifying what results.
- (7) Seek Christian public information and problem solving methods for a clear violation of national sovereignty and its territorial dispute.
- (8) Select Christian peace city among world countries.
- (9) Establish a Council of World peace ambassador with bylaws governing their job said Council will guide.

 - Associate Members: Mayors of world Christian peace cities

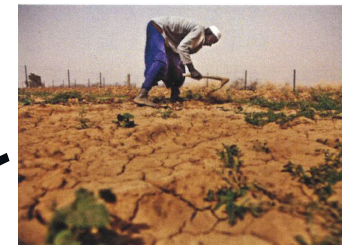
2. DEPARTMENT OF INTERNATIONAL MILITARY SERVICES

- (1) Seek military security methods for preventing terrorism.
- (2) Seek Christian way of suppressing and reducing the production of nuclear weapons.
- (3) Seek Christian way of disposing of chemical weapons.
- (4) Seek data collection to identify countries or companies supplying illegal weapons to terrorist organizations, multi-national criminal organizations, and weapons trafficking organizations.
- (5) Thru sanctions on countries or companies, block illegal weapons trade.



3. DEPARTMENT OF INTERNATIONAL CHRISTIAN JUSTICE

- (1) International Investigation:
 - Investigation into the systematic persecution of Christians and Christian missionaries.
 - Data collection and investigation into hate crimes against Christians in every country.
 - Investigation of cyber crimes against Christianity and Christians.
- (2) International Drug Eradication:
 - Expose of drug cartels and collected data on drug distribution organizations.
 - Public education and information on drug eradication.
- (3) By utilizing public international law:
 - Indictments for crimes persecutions involving against the Christians and Christian missionaries anywhere in the world.
 - Seek methods for bringing these issues to the attention of the media in the US and the world press to expose and intervene with these crimes.



4. DEPARTMENT OF INTERNATIONAL FOOD SECURITY

- (1) As practicing Christians, deal with the impending global food crisis that lies ahead. By doing so, WCO plays a leading role in solving the problem of social ecological & biological critical situation on the global food crisis.
- (2) In search of methods for administering and managing WCO's own way of grain production and distribution in the country with the largest farmland in the world.
- (3) Establish grain terminals and storage buildings in every country coping with food shortage.
- (4) Establish methods to distribute surplus grain.
- (5) Promote the increase rate of food production by improving agricultural techniques (know-how) and directing flood control system in third world countries such as African countries.
- (6) Help fight against global poverty through WCO's taking initiative in developing new disease and drought resistant seeds to combat food shortages and to secure new technologies in food production.
